Even though the Court intends to issue more detailed rulings with respect to the matters heard on November 19, 2012, in the interest of time<sup>1</sup>, the Court issues the following rulings and orders:

1. With respect to construing the Trust provisions, the Court rules in favor of the Objectors/Respondents. The Trust can not be construed as giving the Trustees discretion to admit female students.
2. Respondents' motion for joinder of Deep Springs Corporation is GRANTED.
3. Respondents' motion for preliminary injunction is GRANTED.
